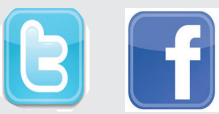

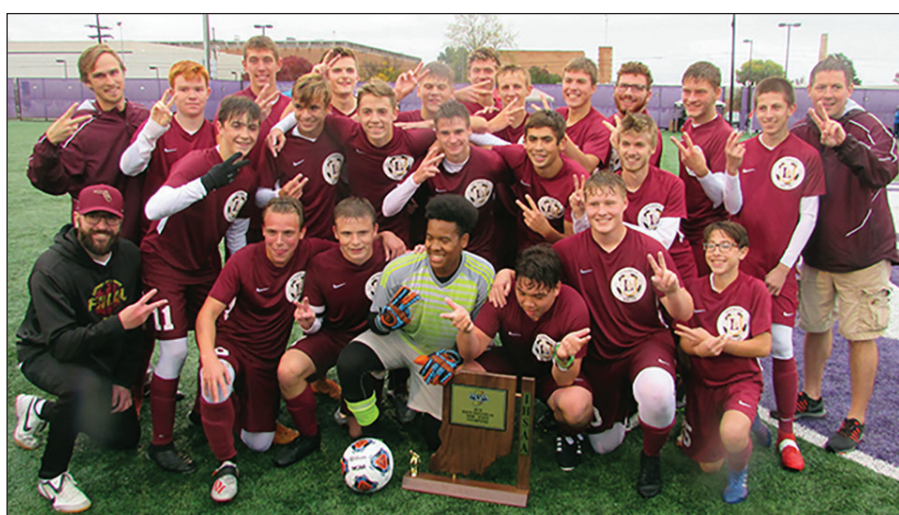

"We did it!" Lutheran defenseman Ethan Tran screamed those words running off the soccer field at Seymour after the Saints guaranteed the Class A team a first-time trip to the IHSAA state championship game Friday at 8 p.m. at Fishers High School.

The underdog Saints exploded for the only goal scored by sophomore Sean Moore only 49 seconds into the second period to defeat Jac-Cen-Del for a rain-drenched 1A Seymour Semistate championship.

After a tense first-period scoreless deadlock, Lutheran coach Ryan Baglow encouraged his team to "attack, attack" in the second period.

And that's exactly what the Saints did. They moved the first possession of the period closer and closer to the goal. In close quarters on the left side near the goal, junior Fred Hamer had moved the ball to Moore.

"I was in the right place at the right time," said Moore of his second game-winner during the IHSAA playoffs. "My mindset was to shoot - go for the open spot. I saw their goalie on the left side; I shot to the right side so he couldn't get to the ball."

They receive professional development training and regular teacher evaluations.

# Saints, Rebels and Woodmen romp

Lutheran coach Dave Pasch said his undefeated Saints would have to be fundamental and physical in their IHSAA 1A Sectional 46 opener at Sheridan.

Pasch was on target because it doesn't get any more fundamental or physical than the Saints domination of Sheridan, 62-14.

Led by Indiana's most prolific small-school runner Marcus McFadden, the Saints racked up nine touchdowns and 485 yards total offense. McFadden scored four TDs that accounted for 174 yards of his game-high 248 yards on the ground.

Lutheran dominated Sheridan in several ways:

- \*485 yards total offense.
- \*Scoring touchdowns of 73, 78, 42, 42 and 37 yards on first plays from scrimmage.
- \*Running their first third- and fourth-down plays early in the third quarter.

- \*Allowed Sheridan only two first downs in the first half.

And the Saints triumph came against legendary coach Bud Wright, who has guided Sheridan to nine state championships.

The Saints were simply too fast and too physical for the host Blackhawks. Lutheran scored on its fourth play with McFadden from the one-yard line.

The Saints second TD was a game-changer. Sheridan attempted a behind-the-line of scrimmage pass that fell short of the receiver. Sophomore d-back Montassi Clay scooped up the football from the 30 and scampered a short distance for a 14-0 lead with seven minutes left in the first half.

The Saints scored five more times in the first half, capped by a short pass from Jalen Elliott to Clay, who turned the play into a 42-yard TD for a 49-14 lead.

At Roncalli, the host Rebels dominated winless Frankfort by piling up 329 yards total offense and holding the Hot Dogs to only 98 yards. Baron Huebler ran for two TDs and 136 yards. Aiden Leffler and Caden Gore threw one TD apiece.

Frankfort's longest gain was eight yards against the Rebels. At Madison, Greenwood pounded host Madison as quarterback Oliver Rau completed only four passes with two aeriels going for TDs. With eight starters out with injuries, the Woodmen led 42-0 at the half.

Each of the three games wound up with a running clock during the second half under first-year IHSAA rules.

## Two CG teams advance

Center Grove's boys cross-country team competes in the IHSAA state finals Saturday morning at Terre Haute and its girls volleyball team travels to the 4A Columbus East Semistate where they face No. 1 New Castle (33-1).

Trojans' runners finished second to Carmel Saturday at the Shelbyville Semistate to qualify for the state final run for the first time. Freshman Drew Costelow, 15th place, 16 minutes, 4.7 seconds, led CG with teammates also scoring points - Achitt Malik, 22nd; Ty Garrett, 23rd; Nick Wilson, 32nd; Jarret Rockwell, 49th.

The boys' run is at 1 p.m. at the LaVerne Gibson course, Wabash Valley Sports Center.

CG's volleyball team finally overcame the Providence jinx by upending the No. 3-ranked Pioneers in a nail-biting five-set win Saturday at Bloomington North. The Trojans had been eliminated by Providence for two straight years.

The No. 10 Trojans (29-6) had a 2-1 lead in sets but Providence scored the final two points in the fourth set for a 26-24 win. CG gained an 8-2 lead in the fifth and final set and held on for a 15-10 triumph and a berth in the Final Four.

The Trojans were led by Madison Hammill, 43 assists, and Ashley Eck, 19 digs. Up front, Katie Egenolf had 14 kills and Grace Boggess, 12 kills.

Roncalli fell to New Castle (25-17, 25-12, 25-13) in the title match in the Greenfield Regional. The Rebels won the morning opener against Avon, 3-1.

At Morristown, Lutheran fell to Bloomfield in the 1A regional opener 3-1. The Saints won a marathon second set, 31-29 to tie the match at 1-1, but dropped the next two sets 25-19 and 25-12.

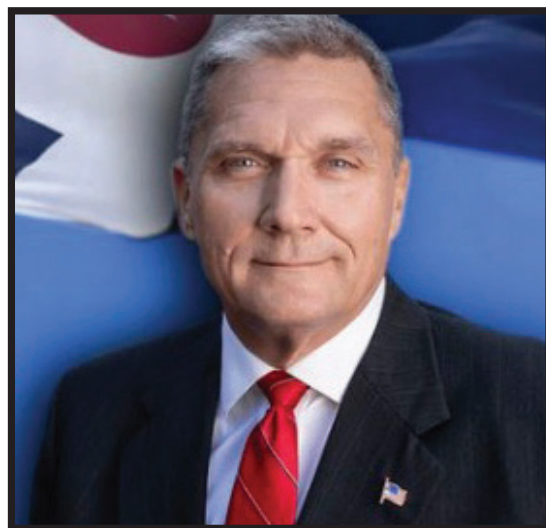
