## Windler becomes first Falcon drafted in NBA

Perry Meridian High School alumnus Dylan Windler became the first Falcon picked in the NBA draft Thursday.

The 6-8 sharpshooter was selected by the Cleveland Cavaliers in the first round, the 26th selection overall.

Windler played for Falcons coach Brent Keck and graduated in 2015. The lanky forward averaged 27.3 points and 10.2 rebounds his senior season but was snubbed for the Indiana All-Star team.

Belmont University in Nashville, Tenn., was his only offer out of high school. The Southside product thrived with the Bruins. In 2019 as a senior he was the only player in the country to average at least 20 points, 10 rebounds, 2.5 assists per game and shoot 40 percent from 3.

He led Belmont to its first victory in the NCAA Tournament in March with an 81-70 win over Temple in the First Four. Belmont fell in the first round to Maryland in a tight game at 79-77.

In addition to basketball, Windler had great success on the golf course for Perry Meridian as a state qualifier.

Windler will join a Cavaliers team that has a new coach in former Michigan coach John Beilein.

He becomes the second Falcon to play in the NBA. Andre Owens, Class of 2000, was undrafted but signed as a free agent with Utah and later played for Golden State, Indiana and in Europe.

## Southport has connection to this year's Triple Crown

A few weeks ago, I received a call from a good friend of mine that lives in Florida. His name is Jesse Blackwell. He is going to be involved in the Edgewood Hall of Fame program that I have been writing about.

We talked for several minutes before he asked me if I remembered a horse farm that was located close to Thompson Road and McFarland Road. I had no immediate memory of such a farm in that area.

I wondered if the farm was on the property where Saint Jude Church and school or nearby on the corner where the Atrium Banquet Hall is located. I checked with several friends that enjoy sharing local history but none of them had any recollection of such a farm in that area.

Directly behind our house and property is the only present day horse farm that I know about. The Southport Equestrian Center is owned and operated by Michelle Soruco. One afternoon, I phoned her and as if she had any information about the horse farm that I was trying to locate.

I then told her that the only other information I had been given was the last name of the original owner of that farm of "Casse." She laughed and told me that I had found that horse farm.

She explained that Norman Casse Sr. once owned their property and that he had built the house that is on the property. She and her family are the third owner and operators of that horse farm.

## Southside patient's genetically modified cells attack lymphoma

Retired Perry Township Schools bus driver Jeff Owens took a gamble a few years ago when he signed up for the CAR T-cell therapy trial with Franciscan Health cancer physicians.

Against seemingly insurmountable odds, the decision paid off.

A new tool, CAR T-cell therapy, is now being used to treat patients whose lymphoma has returned after being in remission following chemotherapy. Franciscan Health authorities have explored the treatment in clinical trials since 2016.

"I've been in remission for nearly two years," Owens said last month. "God's grace and this clinical trial saved my life. And I want it to help others, too."

In 2017, the odds seemed

stacked against the Southside resident. After discovering a mysterious bump on his left arm and encouragement from

his wife Judy, he consulted with physicians at Franciscan Health Cancer Center. Tests revealed the large B-cell lymphoma, which had

been in remission after an earlier stem cell transplant at the Indiana Blood & Marrow Transplantation (IBMT) program, had reinvaded his body.

"I had a couple of options but mostly they would have been Band-Aid treatments," Owens recalled. "The doctor told me I could have chemotherapy and radiation and that might put me in remission for a time, but it was only a matter of time before the lymphoma came back."

Owens also was offered another choice: IBMT had just launched the CAR T-cell therapy clinical trial and he was a good candidate. So, he readily enlisted in the study and became one of the first in the nation to do so.

"I believe all healing comes from God and that he puts doctors, nurses and medicine out front to help the process

along," said Owens, a west-side Indianapolis resident. "Judy and I discussed it first and we agreed the T-cell trial was the right thing to do."

Compared to rigorous chemotherapy and other treatments he had received in the past, including a bout with colorectal cancer in 2008, the process "went like a breeze and I was on my way home."

A few weeks later, he received three days of chemotherapy to enhance the immune effects of the CAR T treatment. The re-engineered cells were returned and infused into Owens' body and the modified cells immediately aimed and attacked the cancerous cells. To this day, they continue to serve as a shield.

The therapy is no longer

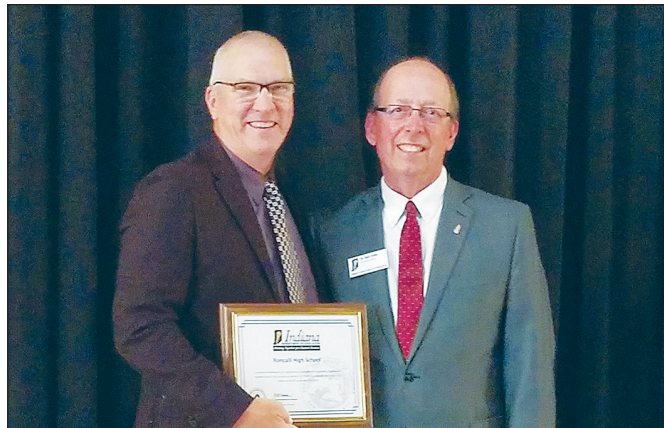

## Tornado aftermath: Beech Grove schools to open on time

I want to reassure you that Beech Grove High School will be back and better than ever! We will begin our 2019-2020 school year as planned on Wednesday, July 31. Although there will be a few changes in the way and where our instruction is conducted at the high school while renovations are being completed, the high quality of instruction will continue and the safety and security of our students and staff will remain our highest priority. The high school campus remains closed and off limits to everyone except authorized personnel. Many thanks to the Beech Grove Police Department for their continued assistance in securing the high school campus. In addition, our contractors on site have done a fantastic job with clean up, securing our building and grounds, and planning for repairs and replacement of

damaged portions of the building and contents. A big thank you to SCS Construction and Moore Restoration. And, special thanks to our high school, administration, transportation, and operations staff members who have been flexible, innovative, and positive throughout this difficult process.

A group of our district staff and contractors are meeting every morning to discuss the progress of clean up and repair and the current assessment of damages. A few of the items discussed and their progress follows:

We have 25 classrooms with water damage at the high school. The three classrooms in the Hornet Enrichment Academy (former Media Center) and the three new science classrooms will not be ready until well into the school year. We will move the students scheduled for these six classrooms to other locations in the building. Many of our athletic facilities were damaged, including the football stadium scoreboard, which was destroyed.

The Central Elementary chiller was damaged beyond repair by the tornado, as well as part of a chiller unit at Hornet Park Elementary. Several trees have been removed from South Grove's property, as well as at the high school, due to their being downed by the storm, or being declared unsafe to remain by our construction company. Minimal damage occurred to South Grove's gym roof. Every day, debris and water is being removed from the high

school building, BGCS Administration, high school, and transportation offices have temporarily been relocated to Hornet Park Elementary. Our damaged buses will be removed to an offsite location on Monday, June 24, for repairs. The electricity has been restored at the high school and administration center. We will send another update next Friday (July 28). In addition, if there is something that needs to be shared before that time, it will be posted to our Beech Grove City Schools Facebook page.

Thank you for your continued support and encouragement. It means a great deal to all of us. We have a great community and we are grateful for each one of you. #BGStrong.

I had some information for her that I didn't believe she was aware of at that time.

I started explaining to her that Norman Casse's son had just trained the horse that had won The Preakness.

The Casse family had moved to Florida and continued raising and training horses. Mark Casse is in charge of their training facilities now. Their horse, War of Will, had been in contention at the Kentucky Derby. It was War of Will that was bumped and stumbled near the finish of the race, officially finishing eighth. Maximum Security was disqualified as the winner, advancing runner-up Country House, a 65-to-1 shot, to the winner's circle.

The only problem during the Preakness was when a horse tossed its jockey off at the start of the race and the horse was rider less but still ran the race. It was great that War of Will got another chance and did so well. The owner of War of Will lives in California and when he calls Mark Casse to check on his horse, he uses the horse's nickname, "WOW."

A couple of weeks later, The Belmont Stakes was held, and I was rooting for War of Will to win the race and have two jewels of the coveted Triple Crown. It's very hard for a horse to recover and be ready for another big race in just a couple of weeks.

War of Will did not place in the Belmont States won by Sir Winston, also trained by Mark Casse. He personally trained two different winners of The Triple Crown.

During the time that the Casse family operated their horse farm here in Perry Township, it was known as Cardinal Training Center. The Casse family has several training centers located both here in the states and in Canada. I read that Mark now resides in Canada and spends quite a bit of time at the Canadian center.

There are several on-line sites that tell about the Casse family and their facilities. It is just amazing that it all seemed to start on the property that is now known as The Southport Equestrian Center - right in our backyard.

"Charlie O'Donkey" (a real live donkey) resides at The Southport Equestrian Center. I've known Charlie for several years, and he informed me that the great grandson of the former Triple Crown winner, Secretariat, now lives at the center.

Our Perry Township / Southport connection to The Triple Crown seems to grow every day.

The therapy is no longer just in research trial phase and is FDA-approved for use with qualified patients at Franciscan Health. There are also open clinical trials available at Franciscan Health for patients who may not be candidates for the approved treatments. Few, if any, options are available to patients whose transplants or chemotherapy fails - and that's what makes CAR T-cells promising.

"This innovative and one-of-a-kind approach to cancer treatment is a game changer," said Luke Akard, MD, a cancer specialist with the IBMT program at the Franciscan Health Cancer Center. "Not only does it offer hope for very sick patients who qualify for CAR T-cell therapy, but it also changes the way research approaches overall cancer treatment."

As of mid-May, six patients have participated in the study since it began and are to be monitored for several years.

Here's how CAR T-cells work: First, the patient's T-cells (essential blood components in the protection against illness and disease) are isolated, collected and analyzed. Then they are sent to a special lab in California where they are processed and genetically modified. This is followed by a rigorous, week-long quality check.

The cells are then returned to Franciscan Health and infused back into the patient and begin to seek and eliminate the cancer cells. The modified cells live on in the body and are designed as a long-term defensive shield against cancer.

Patients undergoing this therapy need to be near Franciscan Health Cancer Center for about a month following the infusion and are regularly monitored for any side effects.

"FDA approval of CAR T-cell therapy is major milestone because it marks the first approved gene therapy treatment in the United States," said Dr. Akard. "More trials are being explored for cellular therapy for many other cancer types and this could be the breakthrough we have hoped for."

IBMT is one of the two programs in Indiana offering full-service transplant care, including bone marrow and stem cell transplants. The center specializes in the treatment of leukemia, lymphoma, multiple myeloma and other blood disorders. The unit's physicians and clinical staff also conduct extensive research and numerous clinical trials.
